These security services are part of the QGISP which is described in the Connectivity section of this document.

Queensland Government agencies are fortunate to have a first line of defence protecting against cyber threats. These protections are currently funded centrally and are available to all users of QGISP at no additional cost.

This first line of defence enabled by the consolidated Internet Gateway provides Denial of Service (DoS) protection, blacklists, intrusion detection and analysis.

These protections enable a co-ordinated government response and potentially provides warnings before incidents occur.
